Revision courses for either one or two subjects will run across a four day programme

OUR COURSES...

Each course will involve an initial assessment to determine the pupil's current level in their chosen subject. Subsequent sessions will then involve a combination of mini-teach on core topic areas and skills needed technique and supported exam practice. All subject courses will have time allocated for 1:1 teacher support, feedback on marked work and time for individual pupils to bring questions on specific topic areas that they would like to work through.

GCSE COURSES

Foundation Maths (AQA/ Edexcel) & Higher Maths (AQA/Edexcel) -Course FULL

Pupils will sit a short initial assessment to allow Mr Sneddon to evaluate their current level and identify areas of strength and weakness in the subject for each pupil. Subsequent sessions will then involve a combination of mini-teach on core topic areas, tips on exam technique and supported supported exam practice.

AQA GCSE English & Edexcel IGCSE English

Through the week pupils will complete timed work involving Comprehension, Transactional Writing, and Creative Writing. They will receive individualised feedback on completed written work and support to improve in each of the key skill areas required for English Literature and English Language, as well as tips on timing and exam technique.

Chemistry

Mr Oehler, Head of Science at KES, will run a series of mini-teach sessions with past paper practise and feedback on structuring an exam response on key GCSE topic areas including Structure and Bonding, Acids and Bases, Organic Chemistry and Calculations.

Physics

Mrs Stevens, teacher of Physics at KES and examiner for both GCSE and A Level Physics, will run a series of mini-teach sessions with supported past paper questions on topics which are common across GCSE exam boards such as Energy Transfers, Electricity and Magnets, Waves and Radioactivity, with a final session on exam technique and 6-mark questions

A LEVEL COURSES (Now Closed)

Chemistry

Ms Miners, teacher of Chemistry at KES, will run a series of mini-teach sessions with past paper practise and feedback on structuring an exam response on key A Level topic areas, including Acid base Equilibria, Redox Chemistry, Organic Chemistry and Spectroscopy.

English Language

Ms Vernon, teacher of English at KES, will run a series of mini teach sessions and past paper/ essay practice using examples and theory in a number of key topic areas such as: Spoken Language, Child Language Acquisition, Language Change, Standard and Non-Standard English, Language and Power.

English Literature

This course is run by published author and KES teacher, Mrs Bruton, who will focus on planning Comparative essays and Passage-based essays, analysis of unseen extracts and compiling quotation banks for OCR English Literature. Pupils will need to bring a copy of their course text with them each day.

Physics

Mrs Stevens, teacher of Physics at KES and examiner for both GCSE and A Level Physics will run a series of mini-teach sessions with supported past paper questions on topics which are common across A Level exam boards, such as Forces and Energy, Mechanics, Electricity, Circular Motion, Waves, Oscillations and Uncertainties.
